## Requirements:

- Qualified degree with focus on sinology or east-asian cultures
- Proficiency in oral and written English
- Proficiency in oral and written Mandarin Chinese (academic level)
- Teaching experience (preferred)

The appointment is initially limited to a period of one year and can be extended for up to four additional years. In order to increase the proportion of female staff members, applications from female scientists are particularly encouraged by the Friedrich-Alexander-University Erlangen-Nuremberg. Preference will be given to disabled persons with the same qualification.
